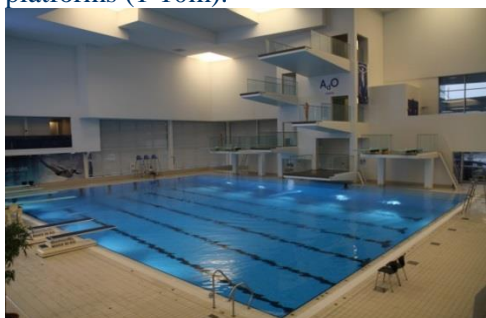

Entry Fee

The entry fee is 150 NOK (about €18) per start for the individual events, and 200 NOK (about €25) per pair for the synchronized event.

Late entries: Entries arriving after March 13^h will be charged 300 NOK (about €36) per start for the individual events, and 400 NOK (about €50) per pair for the synchronized event.

All clubs have to pay the entry- before April 1st. Participating clubs will receive an invoice after sending entry-form.

All payment is in Norwegian currency!
