BRAZIL OPEN DIVING 2015 BRASÍLIA/DF, BRAZIL DECEMBER 10-13, 2015

The Brazilian Swimming Federation (CBDA) is pleased to invite your Federation to participate in the Brazil Open Diving 2015 held in Brasília from December 10-13, 2015, at the Centro de Excelência em Saltos Ornamentais da Universidade de Brasília, Distrito Federal, Brazil.

Number of Divers: There is no limit of inscription of divers or teams per event, however, only two divers per club or federation can advance to the finals. In Synchronizing events, that are direct finals, only one team per federation can receive medals.

Housing and Payment: The meet headquarters hotel will be at The Sun Hotel and Resort in the North Touristic Hotel Zone. The hotel is located at SHTN Trecho 2, Lote 4 - Asa Norte, Brasília/DF, Brazil, approximately 10 minutes from Centro de Excelência em Saltos Ornamentais da UnB. The Organizing Committee will provide transfer hotel-pool-hotel to all participants staying at the official hotel. Accommodations and meals will be at a cost of \$105.00 (USD) per person per day for double occupancy and \$145.00 (USD) per person per day for single occupancy. For those who may choose not to stay at the host hotel, a flat rate of \$150.00 (USD) per person will be required. Incidentals and/or extra expenses will be the responsibility of the participant(s) or the Federation they represent. A minimum down payment of 50% of the full amount due should be sent to Brazilian Swimming Federation by November 6th, 2015.

Entries: Preliminary entries with hotel requirements are due October 2nd, 2015 and final entries and final payment by November 6th, 2015. We are unable to guarantee availability of rooms after November 6th, 2015. All entries must be sent by e-mail to saltos@cbda.org.br.

Visa Assistance: Some countries will need visa to enter in Brazil. To attend an





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sporting event in Brazil, the most appropriate visa to apply for is a Visitor Visa. Please e-mail saltos@cbda.org.br if you require an official invitation to apply for visa.

Medical Insurance: The Organizing Committee will provide first aid and lifeguard at the pool if required at all times. Individual Federations are responsible for all other necessary medical expenses.

Doping Control: Doping tests will be conducted by an accredited laboratory in accordance with FINA doping control rules.

Results: Results will be posted following each event by the competition office near the pool. Live results will be available through www.divemeets.com and for the families and federations back home.

Travel: Air travel must be arranged for arrival to and departure from Brasília International Airport Juscelino Kubisheck (BSB). Transportation WILL NOT be provided to or from any other airport. You will receive information on the ground transportation arrangements prior to your arrival.

We really hope you will be able to participate in the BRAZIL OPEN DIVING 2015 in Brasília. Come and visit us and explore Brazil, the country that will host the next Olympic Games Rio 2016. If you should have any questions or need additional information, please do not hesitate to contact us.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The BRAZIL OPEN DIVING 2015 comprises the following events:
1 meter springboard, 3 meters Springboard, 10 meters Platform, 3 meters Springboard Synchro, 10 meters Platform Synchro, 3 meters Mixed Synchro, 10 meters Mixed Synchro and Team Event.

The Brazil Open Diving 2015 will be run in a particular format, that consists in preliminary and final. All the divers compete in the preliminary and the top ranked divers advance to the final.

The 1 meter springboard and the synchronized events are held as direct finals and only the two best divers in individual event and the best team in synchro events counts and may go to the podium for the medals.

Awards

The three best qualified divers or teams in each event will get Medals. All divers taking part in the competitions will get diplomas.

A panel of seven judges will be used for the individual events and nine judges for the synchro events.
