B-group: Born 2002 or later:

1m and 3m: FINA's B-series DAG 3.2 (<u>Girls</u> 5+3 dives & <u>Boys</u> 5+4 dives) Platform: FINA's B-series DAG 3.2 (<u>Girls</u> 4+3 dives & <u>Boys</u> 4+4 dives)

C-group: Born 2004

1 m and 3m: FINA's C-series DAG 3.3 (<u>Girls</u> 5+2 dives & <u>Boys</u> 5+3 dives) Platform: FINA's C-series DAG 3.3 (<u>Girls</u> 4+2 dives & <u>Boys</u> 4+3 dives)

Entry Fee

The entry fee is <u>175 NOK</u> per start for the individual events, and <u>250 NOK</u> per pair for the synchronized event.

<u>Late entries:</u> Entries arriving after March 13th will be charged <u>350 NOK</u> per start for the individual events, and <u>500 NOK</u> per pair for the synchronized event.

All clubs have to pay the entry and accommodation before April 1st. Participating clubs will receive an invoice after sending entry-form.

All payment is in Norwegian currency!

Diving Sheets:

Bergen Open will run the DiveCalc program. You will be able to enter the divesheets online.

All sheets will be posted on the results-wall, the day before the event, and changes can be made up to one hour before the event starts.

Accommodation, food & social meet

Booking must be done before the 31st of January 2017.

For those who arrange other accommodation, there will be a fee of 500,-NOK per person per day.
