Accreditation

Federations entering the European Junior Diving Championships will receive accreditation free of charge for:

- a) the President of the Federation
- b) the Head of Delegation
- c) the entered Competitors
- d) one medical person, a second medical person in case more than fifteen competitors have been entered.
- e) team staff members:
- 5 for up to 5 competitors
- 6 for up to 8 competitors
- 7 for more than 8 competitors.

However the number of team staff members may not exceed the number of competitors.

Team staff members include everybody servicing the team: Team Leaders, Chaperones,

Coaches, Physiotherapists, Interpreters, etc. (not officials such as judges, referees, etc.).

Officials

- **J-D 7.1** Acting Judges are not allowed to act as coaches throughout the actual Championships. Judges who do not respect this Regulation shall be excluded from the Championships.
- J-D 7.2 The TDC shall appoint the Technical Delegate, the Referee, the judges panel(s) and the other officials for each event.
- **J-D 7.3** Federations may nominate one (1) or two (2) judges qualified on the current A- and/or B-Lists of LEN. LEN G-Judges may be entered and may be used in case the number of entered A- and B -Judges is too low.
- **J-D 7.4** Federations entering four (4) divers or more are obliged to nominate at least one (1) judge qualified on the current A and/or B Lists of LEN. A Federation not providing a judge in the category prescribed shall pay a fine of one thousand (1.000) EURO to LEN.
- J-D 7.5 Nominations shall be submitted to the LEN Office no later than the date circulated by the LEN Office.
- **J-D 7.6** Officials approved by the TDC are on the costs of the nominating Federation.
- **J-D 7.7** The Organising Federation shall supply all other officials.
- J-D 7.8 Acting judges may be evaluated.



Training times

The pool is available for training and competition for all Teams as follows:

- June the 19th-26th from 08.00 to 19.30 hours
- June the 27th to July the 3rd from 07.30 hours to start of competitions and from the end of competition till 19.30 hours
- Designated pool slots will be announced.

Team Leaders Meeting

The team leaders meeting will take place on June 26th at 10.00am in the Audetorium at the pool, followed by Technical Officials Meeting and Clinic.

Doping Control

During the Championship the doping control may be conducted. Any competitor participating in the Championships may be required to be tested for doping control.

Opening Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on June the 26th at 16.00 hours. The Team Leader has to choose two athletes (boy and girl) dressed on his/her National outfit for the parade to represent their country.

National Anthems and Flags

The Organizing Committee requests that all Federations check their National anthems and flags at the Team Leader Meeting.

Victory Ceremonies

Award Ceremonies will take place at the end of each final competition.

Awards

Medals will be awarded to the competitors placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each individual, synchronized and Jump diving events. For all events diplomas will be awarded to the competitors and teams placed from first (1) to eight (8).



Passport Check

The passport check will be at the accreditation desk/before the technical meeting.

Insurance & Safety

The Insurance of the participants is at the responsibility of the respective Federations. Lifeguards & safety equipment will be provided for training and competition. An Ambulance will be positioned outside the venue.

Confirmation of the Return Travel

At the Team Leader Meeting each Team Manager must confirm the teams time of departure.



- full Olympic standard platforms (1-10m)
- AdO arena also has a dry-land area with mats, 2 x trampolines and 3 x dryboards.

There will be an Age-group B category (2002-2003) and an Age-group A category (2001-2000-1999).

Entry Rules

- **J-D 3.1** Entries will be accepted regardless of standards.
- J-D 3.2 The events will be held according to the FINA Diving Age Group Rules (Categories A and B).
- J-D 2.3 In individual diving events two (2) entries per Federation and per event may be submitted.
- J-D 2.4 In synchronized diving events, one (1) team per Federation may be entered.



Format for the Diving Events

- Individual diving events on 1m, 3m and Platform will be held in two sessions with Preliminaries and Finals with twelve (12) divers. The starting order of the divers in the Final will be according to the reverse order of their placing as determined by their total scores at the end of the Preliminaries. All divers start with zero (0) points. In the Finals, the top twelve (12) divers from the previous session will participate in a final competition performing only dives without limit. The scores of the dives with limit from the previous session will be carried forward and added to the scores in the final competition to determine the top twelve (12) rankings. Divers lower than the twelfth place will be ranked by their preliminary scores.
- The synchronized diving events shall be held in Finals only.
- The Jump Event is a mixed team event where up to 4 divers by team may be used to complete the 5 dive series from different heights. One (1) team per Nation is allowed in this direct final. The Jump Event is an official medal event with medals for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

A total of 5 dives and minimum 4 groups must be used.

This competition shall comprise five (5) dives; two (2) rounds of dives with an assigned degree of difficulty of 2.0 for each dive regardless of formula, and three (3) rounds of dives without limit of degree of difficulty. The five (5) dives must be selected from at least four (4) different groups.

Attractions in Bergen

Explore local traditions and history at more than 60 different attractions in Bergen. In Bergen you can visit popular attractions like Bryggen, Fløibanen Funicular, Bergen Aqaurium or the famous Fish Market.

Bryggen is one of the biggest attractions in Bergen. Bryggen is included on Unesco's list of World Heritage and is an important part of the city. To stroll through Bryggen's narrow alleyways and overhanging galleries is to step back into the mists of time and a bygone era. Bryggen is very much a living part of the cultural heritage that is still in active use in this historical area of the city. Today, there are several attractions in the Bryggen area, from the Fish Market to Bergenhus Fortress as well as many cafés, restaurants and shops to choose from. Many of the shops sell traditional and unique crafts.

Edvard Grieg Museum Troldhaugen, just outside the center, was the famous composer Edvard Grieg's home for 22 years and is also one of the popular attractions in Bergen. The decor in the living rooms is Grieg's own from 1907. In the summer you can enjoy a visit to the museum and include a lunchtime concert.

Bergen has an impressive collection of unique Norwegian and international art treasures ranging from the classical to the contemporary. The collections are housed in a row of galleries lining the picturesque Lille Lungegårdsvann lake in the heart of the city with major collections of Munch, Tidemand and Gude, Picasso as well as contemporary art, craft and design, a unique Chinese collection and, not least, the silver collection at KODE.

Until the 1830s, Bergen was the biggest town in Norway and the largest in Scandinavia for a period during the Middle Ages. The reason for this was that Bergen was a major European trading and seafaring port and one of the Hanseatic merchants' four most important trading centres. The buildings of the Norwegian Fisheries Museum, some of them older than Bryggen, and a harbor with traditional boats creates a beautiful setting for the stories about fishing traditions in Norway.
