Kranj - A Place for Opportunities.

When the town of Kranj was asked to host the European Masters Championships, we approached the project with great dedication. We began by inspecting all the sports facilities and capacities required for competitions on such a high level, and ascertained that they all fulfil the requirements for a European championship.

I am proud that we – the City of Kranj, together with the Slovenian Swimming Federation and the SI sport company as the event organizer – saw this event as an opportunity to raise the visibility of Kranj, to bring swimming closer to the general public and to get confirmation that Kranj owns and manages a sports infrastructure of an international standard.

In terms of numbers, as many as 6,500 active participants are expected to take part in the competitions; together with their accompanying persons there will be around 10,000 guests at the European championship – this will be a valuable experience for us, both in terms of organising the competitions and the accompanying programme. I am certain that the participants will have memorable experiences that will leave lasting impressions of our country.

Our town will host competitions in as many as three aquatics disciplines in which European swimming masters will compete against international rivals. The swimmers of different disciplines, including synchronized swimming and water polo will have the chance to try out Kranj's swimming pools.

In terms of size, economic activities, education and training options, as well as the extent of administrative functions, Kranj represents the centre of the Gorenjska region. In the past, it was known as a highly-developed industrial town, while today it is transforming into a modern information and technology development centre, as well as an educational and cultural hub. The town has always been considered a sports town offering many opportunities to both amateur and professional athletes. Kranj offers a good Sports Centre with a swimming complex (an indoor and an outdoor swimming pool), an athletic stadium with a grass field for throwing, a football stadium, tennis courts, a tennis hall, two outdoor basketballs courts, a rollerblade track and outdoor fitness equipment.

As for water sports, in the 1970s and 1980s, Kranj was known for two remarkable swimmers, brothers Borut and Darjan Petrič, and from the younger generations, for the two athletes Emil Tahirovič and Anja Čarman. Today, two young swimmers Urša Bežan and Tjaša Vozel are starting their sports careers, both participating in the Summer Olympics, as well as the swimmer Peter John Stevens.

Furthermore, national water polo and swimming teams come from abroad to train in Kranj. The most well-known regular guest in Kranj is the Serbian national water polo team.

Kranj's athletes have been very successful not only in aquatics sports, but also in ski jumping (Triglav Skiing Club with the Prevc brothers and Robert Kranjec), and football – the emerging football players in the Slovenian premier league. Furthermore, regular and professional practices are creating new talents in most team sports (handball, basketball, climbing, archery).

Last but not least, the capital of Gorenjska is also a great starting point for trips around the region and Slovenia. With the participants of the European Masters Championships and consequently with this great sports event, we will enrich the story of the visibility of Kranj and confirm the quality of recreational activities in an exemplary urban environment in the embrace of a mountain landscape.

Welcome to Kranj, welcome to the Gorenjska region, and welcome to Slovenia!

Ljubljana is the capital of Slovenia with around 300,000 inhabitants. It is home to a number of museums, theatres, an opera, a botanical garden and a zoo. Old medieval, baroque and art nouveau buildings coexist with modern buildings, which in spite of their impressive size do not overshadow the valuable heritage of architect Jože Plečnik, renowned throughout Europe.

The diverse landscape is reflected in the diverse cuisine and its rich tradition. You can have anything from the sausage kranjska klobasa in the Alpine world, dumplings (štruklji) and nut roll potica in central Slovenia, the prekmurska gibanica cake and braided loaves in the Pannonian area, to roast sardines and Mediterranean mussels in the coastal area.

The diversity of dishes is rounded off by wines. These range from quality and premium wines to predicate and sparkling wines. Wine growing areas are intertwined by wine and tourist roads, wind rattles and wine cellars, with the Ptuj wine cellar standing out due its longest tradition.

Also, the eastern and north-eastern parts of Slovenia are especially rich with wells of thermal and mineral water. The country has fifteen health centres which have received the certified status of a natural health resort. Europeans have known and trusted the healing effects of Slovene thermal and mineral water for more than four hundred years.

Kras, a rocky landscape exposed to the Karst north wind burja, overgrown with bright-red smoke plants and intertwined by cycling routes, is a Slovene peculiarity. The dissolution of rock has caused numerous landscape features to develop on the Karst ground, including underground caves, passages, intermittent rivers and disappearing lakes, as well as dry and blind valleys. With its colourful and diverse landscape, Slovenia is suitable for a number of activities. Caving here has a centuries-old tradition. Around twenty out of the total of 7,000 registered caves and potholes are open for tourists.





KRANJ



The old town of Kranj is one of the most charming in Slovenia and it is protected as a cultural monument. The towers of the main Gothic church and ancient defense towers shape the city. The old town is rich with houses, which are a vivid memory of the Bourgeoisie Era in Kranj. Many peoples have crossed Kranj in its rich 6000-year history. Today, the old town hosts many events and a vivid art scene. Make time for a leisurely stroll around the galleries, cafes and small shops. Discover architectural and cultural heritage. Getting to know the city with experienced guides, full of anecdotes and urban legends, is so much fun! At every step, you can feel the affection for culture and the greatest Slovenian poet, France Prešeren and other great men of Kranj.



Kranj was built at the rock, surrendered by two wild rivers Sava and Kokra. The town rises above 30-metre deep canyon. Having one leg in the city and the other in nature, the Kokra river canyon just below the city is a unique phenomenon. A walk along the river banks is a refreshing experience. On the other side, the old town is embraced by the river Sava, a true paradise for anglers and fishermen. Under the old town, there are hidden galleries and tunnels, a town shelter, built during World War II, nowadays used for cultural and entertainment events and definitely worth visit.

Kranj is one of the liveliest cities in Slovenia, bursting with concerts, exhibitions, culinary shows and artisan fairs. Today, between the castle walls, towers and old town houses, many events take place alongside a vivid art scene. Visit our galleries and museums, which are open every day of the week except Mondays. Summer in Kranj is lively from June until September. Don't miss Jazz Camp the end of August and many other summer festivals and check other cultural events at www.visitkranj.com.

One of the biggest advantages of Kranj is that nature is only a step away from the town. Experience our green, active and healthy Slovenia from Kranj, which is an excellent base for outdoor activities and exploring Slovenia. BLED - A JEWEL AMONG THE ALPS



The eternal allure of Bled lies in its magical lake, a shimmering body of crystal-clear water embraced by a necklace of snow-capped Alpine peaks. Atop the lake reigns Slovenia's only island, crowned by a 15th-century chapel safely guarding its wishing bell, while high above it broods a mighty medieval castle.

Visitors to Bled are inspired by its mild climate, fresh air, plentiful sunshine, clean water and tranquil serenity and charmed by the time-honoured 'pletna' boats that slowly glide across the lake. Horse-drawn carriages add to the town's traditional flair, while the delicious cream cakes have also passed into Bled folklore, having been baked here since 1953, when the original recipe was invented.

Bled and its surrounding area, much of which falls within the Triglav National Park, ensure plentiful opportunities for spending an active day in the great outdoors, including golf on one of the most beautiful courses in Europe, white-water rafting, cycling and hiking. Recently, Bled's ambitious and cosmopolitan chefs, who like to give new interpretations to the typical traditional dishes of the area, have managed to establish themselves among the very best in the country, thus adding to the pleasures of visiting Slovenia's Alpine pearl.



BLED





JESENICE



Jesenice, a former centre of iron and steel processing, is located in the northwestern part of Slovenia. The town stretches along the deep, narrow valley where the Sava River passes through Mt. Mezakla and the Karavanke mountain range. In the north, the area borders Austria, with the border running along the mountain peaks Klek, Golica and Suha Pass and in the west the region ends with the Karavanke tunnel providing for the shortest route from Slovenia to the Western Europe.

Discover town Jesenice, whose heart beats in the town of Stara Sava - an erstwhile steel mill settlement, which seems like a sanctuary of human strength and faith in progress.

The Karavanke Mountains and other popular beauty spots such as Mt. Golica, famous for white narcissi in May, surround Jesenice, capturing the admiration of either a native or an eventual traveler to Jesenice region from abroad.





KAMNIK



Kamnik, a town embraced by the Kamnik-Savinja Alps, is considered one of the most beautiful mediaeval towns in Slovenia. In the Middle Ages it was a flourishing trading town and the seat of the Counts of Andechs from Bavaria. At that time, Kamnik was the capital of Carniola. The first written sources about Kamnik date back to 1229. The two castles of Kamnik, Mali grad and Stari grad, were mentioned even earlier. The town boasts a rich Franciscan library, where about 10,000 volumes of books printed before the end of the 18th century are kept. Šutna is the most beautiful street in the town, featuring typical signboards and other signs of the lively craft activities in the past. Take a stroll along the street and discover numerous attractions, including the birthplace of Rudolf Maister, the

Parish Church of Mary Immaculate with a separate Gothic bell tower, the Sadnikar Museum, and the birthplaces of many other renowned inhabitants of Kamnik. The passage Samčev prehod marks the end of the Šutna Street. In the past, there was a natural slope there, which separated Šutna from the mediaeval town, acting like a natural barrier. Owing to its surroundings – Velika Planina, Stari Grad, the valley of Kamniška Bistrica, Terme Snovik, Arboretum Volčji Potok – it is place you can visit in any season.

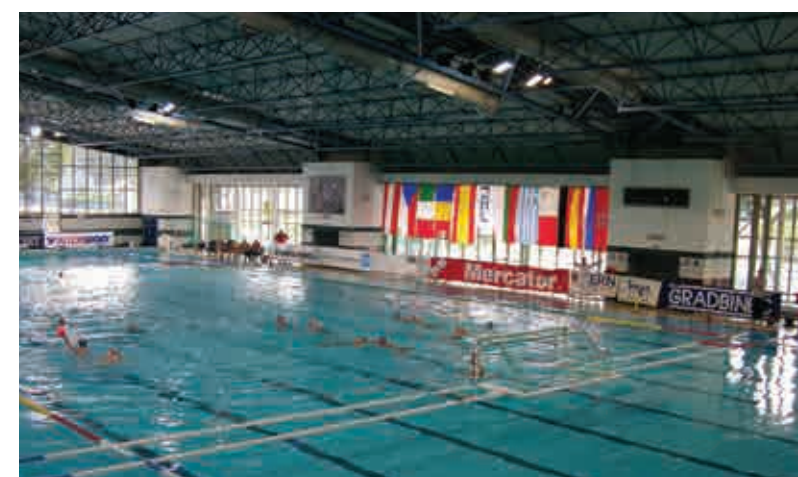

Kranj swimming pool complex is considered one of the most beautiful facilities in this part of Europe. The indoor and outdoor Olympic swimming pools are directly connected; both have ten lanes and a great deal of room for competitors. The complex also has other facilities such as gym, sauna, spa and solarium centres.

The indoor pool, which was renovated in 2014, will serve mainly for swimming practices.

The outdoor pool was opened in 2003 for the European Water Polo Championships and the European Masters Water Polo Championships.

Between the two pools is a sunbathing area and a children's area with small pools and whirlpool baths.

RADOVLJICA, which is a 15-minute drive away from Kranj, has an additional outdoor swimming pool. In case swimming trainings in Kranj will not be possible on 1 September 2018, trainings will be organized in Radovljica, with shuttle transportation organized from Bled and Kranj.

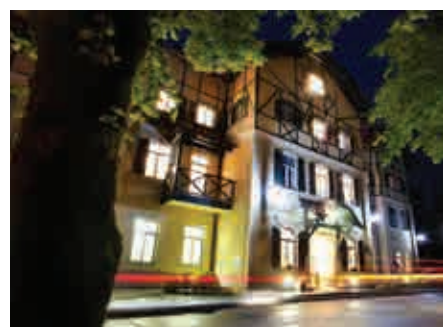

Days of National Costumes and Clothing Heritage

6 September 2018 – 9 September 2018

The biggest ethnological festival in Slovenia attracts more than 30,000 visitors every year.

Tradition Connects

Every September, tradition joins forces with ethnography, culture and entertainment. The central event brings together more than two thousand fans and connoisseurs of group-specific costumes, while the programme also includes an offer of traditional Kamnik dishes.

The Days of National Costumes and Clothing Heritage are considered to be the biggest ethnological festival in Slovenia, priding itself on a more than 40-year tradition, with the 47th event taking place this year. The beginnings of the event date back to 1966 when Kamnik citizens organized the Day of National Costumes. Already in its first year, a great number of educational societies and individuals, both from Kamnik and its surroundings, attended the event. The event has changed names quite a few times; thus in 1986, Kamnik hosted the 16th Days of National Costumes, Folklore and Crafts, which was later changed to Days of National Costumes and Clothing Heritage – a name that has been preserved to this day, with the event becoming widely renowned through its numerous content changes.

Every year the festival's programme attracts over 30,000 visitors, as well as media from Slovenia and abroad. The festival is the pride of the town, and the locals like to refer to it simply as "Costumes".

TUNNELS UNDER THE OLD TOWN OF KRANJ

There are 1,300m of long tunnels under the old town that were used as a bunker about 70 years ago, but have now been transformed into a tourist attraction. They are full of stories from the time of World War II and offer a reconstructed war shelter and a simulated experience of an airstrike. You can also see real stalactites and cave-dwelling animals inside. For you, we have prepared a tasting of the famous local culinary tandem in the tunnels, that is the Kranj sausage, which has been the recipient of a gold medal for several consecutive years, and Kranj beer from a local microbrewery.

FAQ – Frequently Asked Questions

How can I participate?

To participate in European Masters Championships 2018 you have to be a member of an European Club for at least 12 months before the start of the competition and you have to meet the posted entry times.

Once entries will be closed, data from the system will be passed to National Federations, which will confirm the belonging of these athletes to the club they selected.

Where can I register?

You can register online on <http://www.emc2018.com/en/registration>.

When will entries close?

The registrations will close on Saturday, 2 July 2018 at midnight. This is in order to enable LEN to send the entry lists to Federations for confirmation of competitors' eligibility to compete in the Championships. Once Federations have confirmed eligibility then the approved entries will enable the LEN Masters Committee to draft the detailed competition schedule which will then be communicated (dependent on information being received from the National Federations).

Are coach passes available for the Championships?

LEN regulation MA-G 3.1 identifies those personnel entitled to accreditation and as such coaches will not receive any accreditation.

Which pool am I going to be swimming in?

Once entries close on 2 July 2018, LEN will undertake a full review of the competition schedule and communicate in advance of the Championships which events will be taking place in which pool. More information will be made available.

Can I register individually?

Only athletes affiliated to a club are allowed to participate in Masters events. You must be a member of an European Club for at least 12 months before the start of the competition.

Once entries will be closed, data from the system will be passed to National Federations, which will confirm the belonging of these athletes to the club they selected.

So yes, athletes can register to events individually from here <http://www.emc2018.com/en/registration>, but they have to specify the club they belong to.

Do I need to register my family members who will be cheering for me?

No, the access to all venues will be open, no tickets or accreditations will be needed for visitors.

How can I make sure that my entry is correct?

You can check or update your entry on Manage your subscription: <http://www.emc2018.com/en/registration>.

I have only registered for 3 swimming events, but would like to add more events. Can I do that?

You can register to up to 5 swimming events plus 2 open water competitions. You can access your registration data at <http://www.emc2018.com/en/registration> with ID received at the confirmation and your e-mail address to add more events.

Is the competition schedule going to change?

The competition schedule of the Championships will not be changing. The Kranj Swimming Complex will open at 6:30 am each day with swimming sessions set to start at 8:00 am each day. Again, further information will be made available later on.

I am finding it expensive to find accommodation where can I look?

The LOC has managed to secure preferential rates at selected hotels, there is a limit to the length of time the LOC can hold these rooms. If you follow the link on the Masters page (<http://www.emc2018.com/accommodation>) this will take you straight to the accommodation booking site provided by the LOC supplier.
