## **Mäkelänrinne Swimming Centre**

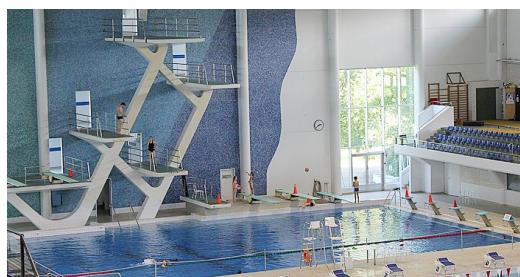
Facilities at the pool:
