### FINA PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE FINA DIVING GRAND PRIX 2019



It is my great pleasure to announce the *FINA Diving Grand Prix 2019*, a yearly competition gathering the world's best divers in a nine-leg circuit which will kick-off in Rostock, Germany, on February 14, 2019.

Nine hosts in the five continents have been announced as part of the 2019 programme: After Rostock, the circuit will stop in Calgary (CAN) from April 4-7. It will then head to Mission Viejo (USA) from April 12-14, Madrid (ESP) from June 7-9, Bolzano (ITA) from June 14-16, Cairo (EGY) on June 21-23. The 2019 edition will then continue in Gold Coast (AUS) from November 8-11, Kuala Lumpur (MAS) on November 15-17 and will conclude in Singapore (SGP) from November 22-24.

Mission Viejo in California is a new comer in the circuit, while the Egyptian capital, Cairo, is the first African host even since the inception of the event.

The Grand Prix is a unique opportunity to enhance the visibility and media exposure of diving worldwide. It provides a platform for divers all around the world to practice at an international level, close to their home.

With the active support of our National Federations, sponsors and partners, and TV networks, the FINA Family celebrates the sport by making it accessible in different regions around the world, by attracting more athletes, more organisers and more spectators, years after years.

I would take this opportunity to express my gratitude and sincere appreciation to all the National Member Federations and Organisers of the FINA Diving Grand Prix 2019. Their commitment, efficiency and support are key factors to the success of this event.

Good luck to all the participants in the FINA Diving Grand Prix 2019 and the best to win!

#### **VIII. COMPETITION FORMAT**

#### **Individual events**

The FINA Diving Grand Prix 2019 will be run according to the tournament format.

#### **Preliminaries**

The top 12 divers advance to the Semi-Finals (Groups A and B).

#### Semi-Finals

*	Group A	12 - 10 - 8 - 6 - 4 - 2
*	Group B	11-9-7-5-3-1

#### **Finals**

The top 3 divers from Groups A and B advance to the Finals (total of 6 divers in Final).

#### Replacement of injured diver

In the case of an injury following the Preliminary competition, the next qualified diver will take the place.

In the case of an injury following the Semi A or Semi B, the next qualified diver of the same Semi-final will take the place.

6 dives without limit

#### Individual diving events

There will be preliminaries, semi-finals and finals:

- Men's individual events 3m and 10m
- Women's individual events 3m and 10m 5 dives without limit

#### Synchronised diving events

There will only be direct finals:

- 2 dives with limit + 4 dives without limit Men's synchro events - 3m and 10m Women's synchro events - 3m and 10m 2 dives with limit + 3 dives without limit
- Mixed synchro events 3m and 10m
- 2 dives with limit + 3 dives without limit

#### **XI. GRAND PRIX COMPETITION RULES**

#### **Conditions of Entry**

- The FINA Diving Grand Prix ("DGP") shall be open to all FINA affiliated Federations.
- Entries of divers in the FINA Diving Grand Prix shall be accepted only from the Federations, Members of FINA.
- Divers age 12 and 13 years on December 31st of the same year shall be eligible to participate (as per age group C).
- Each host may invite additional divers to compete in the events as they deem appropriate.
- The maximum number of divers who can participate in an individual DGP event is four (4).
- Any Federation with more than two divers in an event may be permitted to advance to the semi-finals only the top two (2) performers in that event.
- The Host Federation may enter two (2) teams in the direct final of a synchro event but only the best team may proceed to the podium.
- No additional divers or teams may participate in a DGP meet, other than those specified in the Rules & Regulations. There will be no opportunity for exhibition places.

#### **Prize Money**

There will be no overall prize money awarded.

#### Rules

- All events shall be conducted in accordance with the FINA Rules, which can be found on the FINA Website (www.fina.org – about FINA – Rules).
- The Organising Federation shall publish the conditions of the event by advising the FINA Office in Lausanne (SUI) at least two (2) months prior to the commencement of the competition.

#### Judges

- A Federation taking part in a FINA DGP meet with a team of four (4) divers or more should bring a judge.
- The judge might, however, also serve as a coach provided that this is not for an event where he/she is judging.
- ◆ A Federation that does not bring a judge will be fined 250 Swiss Francs payable to FINA.



#### **XII. ORGANISERS SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

#### Conditions of entry

Teams can enter maximum of 4 divers who can participate in an individual event

#### **XIII. DOPING**

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with FINA rules.

#### **XIV. MEDICAL CARE, LIFEGUARDS**

During the official times and dates of the training and competition there will be a lifeguard and medical care in the diving pool area for the competitors.

The SAMUR (Madrilenian Service for Emergencies) will have during the days of the competition an alert for the ambulances of the area which will be in contact with the medical services of the organization.

There is one of the biggest Hospital of the Capital (Hospital Gregorio Marañon) at 400 m from the venue.

Free physiotherapy treatment will be offered by volunteer university students.

#### **XV. RESULTS**

The complete results can be uploaded in the following web: www.rfen.es

- Following each session, the results (preliminary results, semi-final results and final results) have to be sent immediately to <u>results@fina.org</u>.
- Right after the conclusion of the event, the Host has to provide an electronic XML file to the FINA Delegate and to FINA (results@fina.org). This file should contain the detailed results including judge's scores for each dive.
